OF BEGINNING.

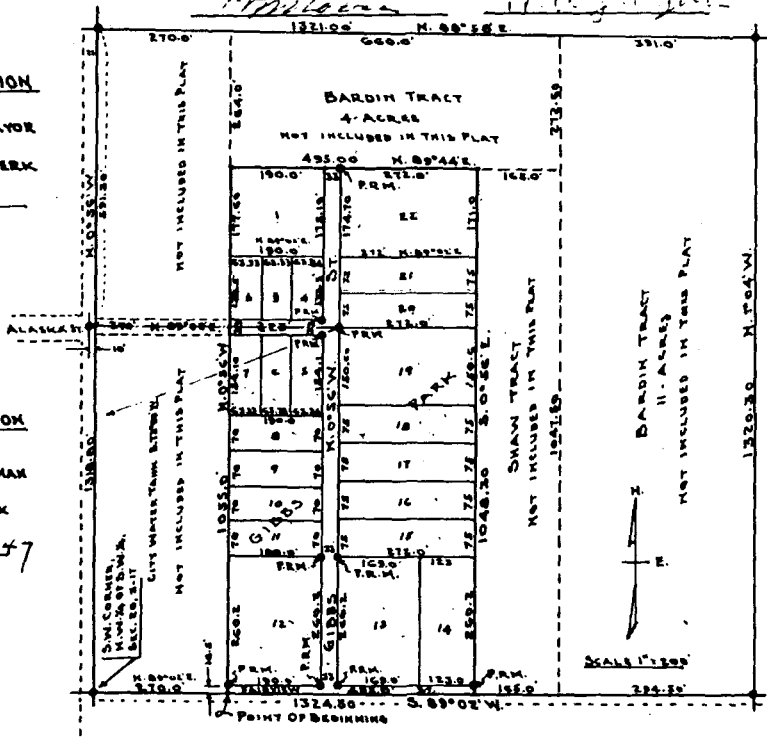
